

# Synchronizing Pages

*Duplicating the layout of one form to others.*

Up until now, I have only focused on the layout of the “View Proposal” screen, and it currently looks like this:

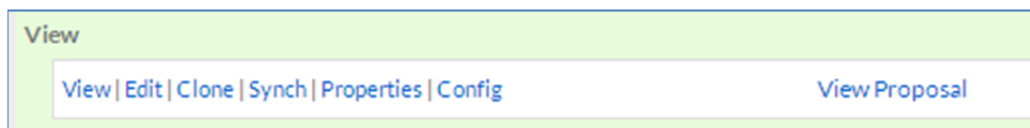

Rollbase fortunately gives us a feature to replicate the look of one screen to the others. If we go under the "Pages" section of the proposal object, you will see a link to "Sync". Note: This process cannot be reversed. Now your edit and new screens will be identical!
